- Learn practical helps for the ministry area they are interested in pursuing
- Add valuable experience to their resume
- Most importantly, experience God in exciting new ways

APPLICATION PROCESS

Please be sure to include your resume, cover letter, and 60-second video in the required boxes. If you have any questions, please email internship@limacc.com. Upon receipt of all required information, candidates may be contacted by a pastor or director for further questions.

Because of the nature of the internship program, we generally only accept applicants who are between the ages of 17 and 25 and who are engaged in an undergraduate or graduate degree program at an accredited institution or a certificate program at a vocational school. It is preferable that the applicant would have completed at least one year of enrollment in such a program. The department for which you are applying for an internship and the degree or certificate program in which you are enrolled should be closely related.

SCHEDULE

The Summer Leadership Institute runs for a 10-week summer term. The schedule the intern is expected to follow will closely mirror that of the pastor or director with which he or she is working and may include involvement during the weekend worship experiences and midweek evening activities.

- Interns will be paid a weekly stipend.
